

## **KEY MATH-3 ESSENTIAL RESOURCES SIGN OUT FROM CENTRAL OFFICE**

The Key Math-3 Essential Resources offers an instructional program to effectively address specific deficits identified by the Key Math 3 assessment kit.

Key Math-3 ER lessons include three to four brief activities designed to maintain a moderate pace of instruction which in turn keeps students engaged in the learning process. Often lessons involve manipulatives or game-like activities that utilize students' natural tendencies to learn through kinesthetic exploration. Lesson displays typically use colorful art to present concepts within high-interest contexts.

The mathematical content is organized into 10 strands which are grouped into 3 content areas: Basic Concepts, Operations, and Applications. Basic Concepts - foundational knowledge, Operations – computational skills, Applications – the ability to apply these concepts and skills to solve problems.

Each level of the program includes:

- a full table of contents for each level, listing all Concept Cluster and lesson titles within each instructional strand
- Guided Practices
- Independent Practices
- Readiness, Review, and Mastery tests
- Alternative Assessments
- answer keys for practice materials and tests
- Class Assignment Record
- Student Progress Report
- supplementary materials
