[PowerSchool Premier's](#) centralized, Web-based solution — which can be accessed anytime, anywhere — allows teachers to store data in one location, while seamlessly generating attendance records, grade checks and report cards.

Light of Christ Catholic School Division parents and students will be able to access assignments, grades and attendance data via the Internet. This will be fully available at [John Paul II Collegiate](#) in the fall and will be implemented over the next year in all our elementary schools.

Teachers will need to enter grades only once into their Web-based grade books. Grades and assignments may be updated daily, and those records will immediately be reflected in the students' grade books. With less data entry, educators will have more time to focus on teaching and preparing lesson plans.

Parents will also have access to the most up-to-date student information.

Upon implementation of the system, parents will receive one login code giving them access to all data of their children, regardless of school. Once these login codes are distributed, parents will be encouraged to log in and provide their e-mail address so that they may receive regular attendance and grade reports as well as other important announcements.

Students can access PowerSchool to view grades and attendance but will not have access to alter account information.
